Waltz is the beautiful dance that never goes out of style. We'll cover the basics of footwork, partnering, leading and following; understanding the structure and rhythm of waltz music. Instruction is based on the rotary (aka turning) waltz style. Course is also suitable for those who know the box-step waltz style, but want to learn this versatile, accessible style.
